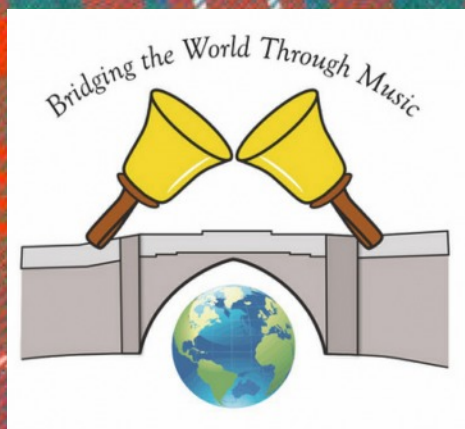


22nd International Handbell Symposium

For over 40 years the International Handbell Symposium has brought together handbell ringers from around the world to foster peace, greater understanding of different cultures and ways of life and to create long lasting friendships through handbell ringing.

From small beginnings in 1984 involving ringers from three countries it has grown to a truly worldwide event with representatives from 5 continents meeting in Japan in 2024.

As we met to 'Ring the Future' in Hamamatsu in 2024 we were able to put some of the challenges of the early 2020's behind us and renew our international partnerships.

Massed Ringing

All ringers will rehearse the 9 pieces chosen by the Guilds from around the world for the final concert. Time is limited so it is important that you are familiar with the pieces before coming to Symposium.

Team Solo Performances

All groups attending are invited to perform **one** piece as a solo item for the other ringers. Please register your groups interest on the registration form.

Workshops

Enjoy attending a choice of ringing and cultural workshops led by registrants from around the world. Symposium choirs of different levels will be offered.

Massed Ringing Concert

The final concert of all of the massed ringing pieces will take place on Saturday. This will be a ticketed concert open to the general public

Friendship Reception

A chance to meet up with old friends from around the world and to make new friends as the Symposium begins. Exchanging pins/small gifts with other ringers is an option.

Chaperones

Guilds are responsible for ensuring that sufficient chaperones attend for the number of young ringers attending. Chaperones must be registered as full delegates and cannot be registered as non ringers.

Registration is individual, members of groups should indicate clearly on their registration form the name of their team/choir.

We will need to know how many tables you need when you register. Only one person from each group should complete this part of the registration. (Changes can be made up to 24th April 2026)

Registrants will be classified as Ringer, Director or Chaperone.

The full registration fee applies to all classifications.

The massed ringing hall will be set up with the following:


-  **Tables.** Tables will be provided. Each table will be 200cm long and 75cm wide. We will need to know how many tables you need when you register.
-  **Foam. To meet fire and safety regulations only foam supplied for the event can be used.** You will need to purchase foam for your tables. Each piece is 100cm x 75cm. You will need two pieces of foam for each table. The final deadline for foam to be ordered is 24th April 2026. Prices and ordering information will be given later.


What to bring?

You will need to bring with you to the symposium

-  **Instruments.** You will need to bring your own handbells, handchimes, mallets, music stands and any other instruments needed for your performances.

If you are considering shipping your instruments please investigate arranging a **customs ATA carnet** from your country of origin.

-  **Music.** All massed ringing music must be purchased in advance and brought to the symposium. Photocopies are not allowed at massed ringing rehearsals or in the performance. If you are performing in a solo concert the music must be purchased in advance and photocopies are not allowed.

-  **Table covers.** Please bring your own table covers. Foam supplied will not be covered,

Workshops

A large programme of workshops will be offered, both handbell and cultural activities will be included. Full details of the programme and registration procedures will be provided to registrants in due course.

Other information

Hotel booking. Preferential symposium rates have been negotiated at a number of hotels. To access these rates you will need to register for the symposium and use the link provided to the Reservation Highway website where bookings can be made. (Once your registration has been confirmed you will be able to access bookings at the symposium rate.)

Other hotels. A selection of other hotels is available approximately a 15-20 minute walk away or 5 minutes by bus (buses every 12-15 minutes). These include Premier Inn, Holiday Inn Express, Leonardo, Hampton by Hilton, Courtyard, Moxi and Crowne Plaza.
